

ENVIRONMENTAL CLAIMS

INFRASTRUCTURE COMPANY

Our insured was retained to excavate a site. They hired a third-party locating company to locate underground pipes. The third-party company erroneously identified the pipes by 150 meters. This resulted in the pipes being struck, releasing natural gas into the environment.

WASTE MANAGEMENT COMPANY

Leak in a casket resulted in a fire at the insured's location. This caused damage to a tank and clean-up costs of almost \$1M.

CONTRACTOR

Fire occurred at an auto wreckers shop arising out of work performed by the insured on a third-party site. Chemicals leaked into the creek behind the auto wrecker shop, which fed into a larger river. Matter resulted in Ministry Of Environment involvement and third-party liability.

CONTRACTOR

Matter arose out of an oil spill on a client's driveway due to a leak from the truck, resulting in clean-up costs.

The claim examples are intended to demonstrate the type of situations that may result in a claim under certain policies and potential outcomes.
